Dear NCCS Members,

NCCS has been receiving feedback and communicating with the authorities and we thank you for their cooperation. We are also heartened to know that many are praying for healing for those who are infected by the disease.

With regards to latest precautionary [measures](#) published by MOH, we were able to clarify through MCCY that the Advisory on "Ticketed events with 250 participants or more to be deferred, cancelled under COVID-19 social-distancing measures" do not apply to churches at the moment. So please note that:

(a) Para 14 on ticketed events for above 250 participants being cancelled do not apply to religious worship services.

(b) However, MCCY encourages churches to put in place robust precautions like the ones listed in para 15 and 16, and ideally limit worship numbers to the 250, if practical.

MCCY will arrange a meeting, within the next 2 weeks, with NCCS and other church leaders to discuss the COVID measures. This time, they will focus on how the churches can apply the social distancing measures to our worship services and other activities.
