An Advent Message: Dear Brothers and Sisters, Grace and Peace be to you and your families from God our Father and our Lord Jesus Christ!

This is a tradition developed over the course of the church's history as a time of preparation for Christmas Day. The English word 'Advent' is from the Latin 'adventus', which means "coming". Advent starts on the fourth Sunday before Christmas and ends on Christmas Eve. This year, Advent begins on the 27 November and ends on 24 December.
