[Prison Fellowship Singapore \(PFS\)](#) will be holding the biennial PFS Prison Ministry Conference on 25 July 2026 as part of outreach efforts to raise awareness for their cause. This conference serves as a

platform to engage, educate and encourage volunteers and supporters by discussing issues of prison ministry work, which goes beyond just the work with inmates and ex-offenders. This year's conference theme is "BREAKING BROKENNESS" where the topics will focus on exploring a holistic ecosystem of healing where restorative practice, mental wellness, and proactive prevention converge to break the cycle of brokenness. The Community Pastoring Seminar 2026 will be held on 18 July 2026 (9am–5pm) at Living Sanctuary Brethren Church (2 Hougang St 22). This one-day intensive seminar is designed for churches wanting to reach the 85% of Singapore's population living in HDB heartlands. Participants will gain a biblically based, step-by-step blueprint for "adopting" their surrounding precinct, along with practical strategies from seasoned practitioners. Workshop tracks include home visits, mobilising resources, partnering community agencies, engaging the next generation, reaching seniors, and starting a satellite centre. See [LINK](#)

PERGAS (Singapore Islamic Scholars and Religious Teachers Association) invited NCCS to present the Christian views on Life, Death and Resurrection, and on Christian Funeral Rites and Practices. This was for their 'Religious Literacy Certificate Programme: Understanding Funeral Rites in Singapore's Multi-Religious Society', organised by PERGAS in partnership with hash.peace, with the support of the Muslim Convert's Association of Singapore (MCAS) (*Darul Arqam*) and the Muslimin Trust Fund Association (MTFA).

Assoc Gen Sec Rev Dr Chiang Ming Shun and Anglican Priest Rev Dr Jeremy-Joe Tan jointly made the presentations. Participants of the programme included *asatizahs* (Muslim religious teachers), together with religious leaders from other faith communities, community leaders, grassroots volunteers, and social service practitioners.
